NOTIFICATION

No. SARIE 300 SAEPA 2007, Bangalore, Dated: 8th July, 2009

Whereas in the Notification No.FTD 161 TMA 90, dated 03.6.92, issued under sub-section (1)(i) of section 67 of the Motor Vehicle Act 1988 (Central Act 59/of 1988), the Government of Karnataka issued directions to the Karnataka State Transport Authority regarding the fixing of fares and freights (including maximum and minimum) in respect of Ambassador Cars, Fiat Cars, Maruthi Cars and Vans and Contessa Cars used as Taxis and chartered by the tourists in the state.

Whereas the Government of India have increased the prices of fuel from time to time and the cost of the vehicles and maintenance cost has increased considerably and also at present, there are many motor cabs of different models operating as Taxis(with air condition and without air condition) and keeping in view, the maximum number of taxis that are operating, the Government have considered it necessary to issue the following directions to the Karnataka State Transport Authority to revise the fares and freights of taxis.

In exercise of the powers conferred under sub-section(1)(i) of section 67 of Motor Vehicles Act 1988 (Central Act59/of 1988), the Government of Karnataka in partial modifications of all directions issued in this behalf in the Notification dated 3-6-92, issue the following directions to the Karnataka State Transport Authority, namely:-

Directions

The Karnataka State Transport Authority is hereby directed to fix the following fares and freights for the taxis such as Ambassador, Maruthi Cars & Vans, Tata Indigo, Ford Ikon, Honda and any other car used as taxis chartered by the tourists/commuters in the State of Karnataka, as follows:-

	Minimum	Per k.m.
Hire charges		
i) Taxi (A/c)	Rs. 40.00 (5 km)	Rs. 08.00
ii) Taxi (without A/c)	Rs. 35.00 (5km)	Rs. 07.00
Waiting charges	Free for the first 30 minutes and thereafter Rs.5/- per hour and part thereof.	
Night Halt charges	Rs. 50/-	

Luggage charges:- No charges for the first 30 kgs.(Suitcase, Bedding etc.) and Rs. 5/- for every additional 20 kgs or part thereof.

Note:- Night from 11 P.M. to the morning 5 A.M., the fare and freight shall not exceed one and a half time of the above fare.
