

:PRESS NOTE:

The Hon'ble Supreme Court of India vide W.P. (Civil) No.13029/1985 dated:24.10.2018 directed in para no.21 is as follows: "Therefore, in exercise of the power vested in this Court under Article 142 of the Constitution, we read down sub-rule 21 of Rule 115 and direct that sub-rule 21 of Rule 115 shall be interpreted and understood to read that no motor vehicle conforming to the emission standard Bharath Stage-IV shall be sold or registered in the entire country with effect from 01.04.2020".

Therefore all the (Except Tractors and Constructions Equipment vehicles) purchasers of Motor vehicles which have already obtained Temporary Registration Certificates of Bharath Stage-IV vehicles must register their motor vehicles on or before 31.03.2020 with the Registering Authority of the state.
